Barriers to learning for pupils eligible for pupil premium funding

The majority of children who receive the pupil premium grant at Meadowdale do not have specific learning needs so our challenge is to provide enrichment and curriculum enhancement. However, some pupils may not be at the expected standard for their age which may impact on their ability to access the curriculum effectiverly. Other barriers for some of our pupils may include financial constraints in accessing a wide range of cultural experience. We are also keen to monitor pupil well-being and ensure that emotional support is provided if needed as we are aware that emotional difficulties can impact on a child's academic progress.
